With a commitment of seven years to the company partners, he collaboratively led the company from a small capital improvement design company to one of the top hospitality design firms in the world. Boyd opened offices in Shanghai, China, as well as Macau. Duncan & Miller Design is now one of the most sought-after design firms in the industry. During this period, Scott also acted as a consultant to a lighting company, Watt's UP, helping it establish significant Asian manufacturing relationships that allowed them to import, market and sell lighting products to the hospitality industry.
